**BIKING** is our main form of transportation! All participants are required to know how to bike. In our summer camp days, our campers bike every day from our studio lab to the destination where the nature part of the day will take place, and back. Training Wheel are not suitable for those long distances. We require campers to know how to bike



**LOCATION** of our camp will be at the Nature Postings Studio. With the renovations that have taken place to increase classroom space and add a second private restroom, we will be able to safely operate in our facility. *Address: 20321 Old Cutler Rd, Cutler Bay, FL*



**EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING** Campers will be able to experience outdoor adventure, science and nature, and research in each day of camp. This approach ensures a great balance between outdoor and indoor activities.

## CAMPERS AND PRICE

To regulate the number of people occupying our facility space, we will be accepting **24 campers per week**. With 6 campers allocated to each team, we will be able to have **2 staff** with the campers and **12 apprentices** to assure quality. This number of campers and staff ratios will ensure safe one on one safety procedures and quality time in each activity. # WHAT TO BRING

## WHAT TO BRING

---

Here is a list of items that you will **NEED** to bring in order to attend the camp.

- Nature Postings Summer Camp Shirt (Provided on the first day of camp)
- Lunch (No Nut Policy) in a separate lunch box. (No microwave is available)
- Refillable water bottle.
- BIKE AND HELMET ARE REQUIRED EVERY DAY!
- **ALL BIKES ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A PLACE TO HOLD WATER BOTTLE.**
- Sunscreen & Bug Spray (Applied prior arrival and add additional in Lunch box)
- Hat
- Towel
- Bathing Suit
- Change of Clothes, including underwear, socks, shoes, etc.
- Closed toe shoes (NO CROCS)
- Water shoes (NO CROCS)
- Any medication required need to be placed in a labeled plastic zip-lock bag and be given to team captain counselor. Counselors are not allowed to administrate medications.
- Plastic bag for wet clothes after water activities
- **ALL CAMPERS MUST HAVE EXPERIENCE BIKING.** Our campers bike up to 10 miles a day. No training wheels are recommended. Training wheels are accepted if the camper can ride up to 10 miles with it.





# CAMP RULES

## RULES

Please read all camps rules. These rules will be discussed the first day of camp:

### 1. RESPECT | *Campers must respect all staff, volunteers, campers, animals, nature and property*

- Follow Directions at all time. Directions are given at the beginning of each activity.
- Keep your hands, feet and objects to yourself.
- No cursing or foul language is permitted at camp.
- Clean up after yourself. Take only memories, leave only footprints.
- NO electronics, cell phones, games or toys are allowed at camp.

### 2. ATTIRE & BELONGINGS | *Campers wear appropriate attire and bring the appropriate belongings*

- Camp shirt is required every day
- Face mask, Lab coat, Safety glasses and Gloves are required at all times indoors.
- Closed –toed shoes are required for all activities
- Sun Screen and Bug Spray must be applied before entering the facility.
- Safety Gear is mandatory during outdoor activities. (helmets, lifejackets, etc.)

### 3. TEAM | *Campers must stay with teams and counselors to ensure safety*

- Follow the number system to account for all campers
- Whistles signals: 1 whistle = STOP, 2 whistles = COME and 3 whistles = EMERGENCY.

### 4. CONSEQUENCES | *Campers who fail to follow rules above will be subject to the following.*

- Three Strike Rule: Campers who fail to follow rules will have three opportunities to correct their mistakes. After each misdemeanor, a strike will be given to the camper and a meeting will take place with the camper and the appropriate guardian. If a camper is given three strikes in one week, they will be sent home with no refund.

Lunch | 12:00 PM to 12:30 PM



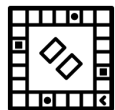
Wild Riders | 12:30 PM to 3:30 PM

# INFORMATION

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Please read all summer camps rules. These rules will be discussed the first day of camp:

- **GOOD BREAKFAST:** It is very important that your child eats good breakfast rich in protein and whole grains before arriving to camp due outdoors activities. Due the intensity of the activities, we need our campers ready for action with a good breakfast.
- **CAMP SHIRT:** We are providing a camp shirt FREE each week. Campers need to wear the shirt every day for easy identification and group control during outdoors activities. Additional camp shirts are available for sale for a cost of \$30.
- **CAMP HOURS:** Camp hours are 8:30 AM- 5:00 PM. Parents will be required to sign in/out their child during drop off and pick up. Only the people authorized in the registration form will be allowed to pick up campers. ID is required during pick up.
- **ARRIVE ON TIME:** We required all campers to arrive by 8:30am. We have prepared a busy schedule that requires travel on bikes to different locations. We will depart for outdoor adventures on time.
- **WEATHER:** All activities are subject to weather. We will notify parents in the morning if any of the adventures have been changed or modified.
- **HOWTO REACH US:** Most of the activities will be outdoors, please note we will be biking, kayaking, snorkeling, etc. with no direct access to our phone. If you need to reach out any of our counselors, please TEXT us at the mobile number (786) 608-3603. We will respond as soon as possible.
- **BIKES AND HELMETS:** Bikes and helmets are required every day. We keep campers bikes locked. We are not responsible for stolen bikes or bikes left in the properties at night. All bikes have to leave after each day and come back the next day.
- **BIKE WATER HOLDER OR BASKET:** To minimize the contact of among water bottles, bikes are required to have a water bottle holder or basket. Camel Water Bags are not allowed!





## CAMP TERMS OF SERVICE

These Terms of Service are applicable to both parents and children attending or participating in any or all summer camp programs or activities associated with Nature Postings Inc.

### GENERAL TERMS

- The directors reserve the right, at their discretion, to withdraw any camper whose influence or actions are deemed unsatisfactory, dangerous or incompatible to the Camp or who will not live within the rules and policies of the Camp. If this occurs, no reduction or return of fee, or any part thereof will be made. Parents will also be responsible for any extra costs associated with returning their child home early.
- Children maintaining the highest standard of conduct is required at all times. Using profanity, disparaging dialogues, physical violence or threats during participation in the Camp is strictly prohibited. Camp rules and instructions of Camp counselors and staff must be followed at all times.
- By accepting these Terms of Service, the parent confirms that his or her child has permission to participate in all camp programs, camp trips, special outings planned and supervised by Nature Postings Inc.

### GENERAL TERMS Part 2

- All your child's personal belongings are their own responsibility, unless loss or damage is proven to be due to Nature Postings Inc. negligence. Expensive and treasured items such as jewelry, designer clothes or shoes, trainers, etc., should not be brought to the Camp.
- All children at Camp are prohibited from bringing or using all tobacco products, alcohol and drugs of any kind.
- No electronic equipment, including but not limited to: mobile phones, computers, TVs and video games are allowed at Camp. No food items, including candy or any nuts related food, are allowed at Camp. Please do not send packages to your child that contain any of these items.

### GENERAL TERMS Part 3

#### CANCELLATION POLICY

- **Registration fees are non-refundable.**
- All sales are FINAL. No REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED.
- Cancellations prior 60 days from the start of Camp will be issued minus the REGISTRATION FEE. After this day NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED.
- Cancellations prior to 30 days from the start of Camp due to medical reasons that can be fully documented with a physician's written explanation may receive a 50% refund of the Camp payments. This provision does not apply to instances of a positive Covid test or a Covid-related quarantine or isolation for any reason. Covid-related issues are instead governed by the 60-day cancellation policy.
- All other cancellations are not eligible for a refund.
- Cancellations made by Nature Postings due to weather or other reasons will be refunded minus registration fees
- You may transfer your registration fees or payments to another person at no cost. Please contact Nature Postings office for any cancellation and transfer requests.
- By payment of any sum to Nature Postings Inc., you are acknowledging your agreement to the Terms of Service of Nature Postings Inc. as described herein.
